## Terms of Reference updated to reflect the project entering its construction phase:

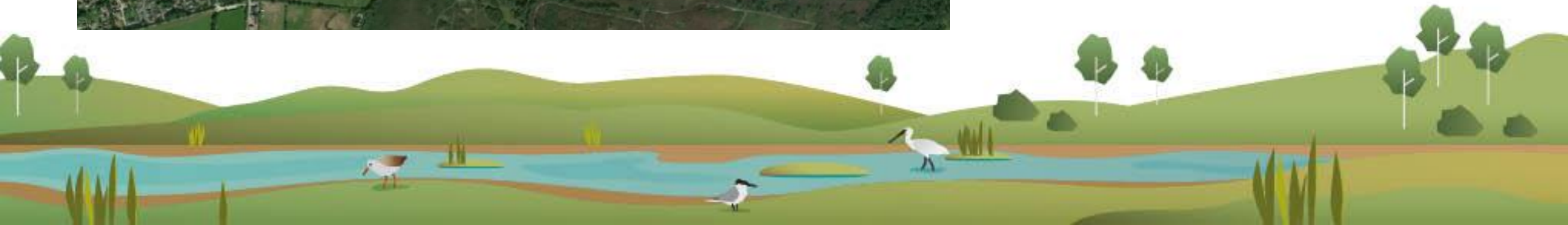
- The Group is an **advisory and information sharing** group rather than a decision-making body, and will consist of interested parties and organisations who may have an interest in the project's delivery.
- The consultation phase for the project has now concluded, the group will now be a space for an engaged audience to **hear about points of interest or development**, and will meet three times each year over the construction phase.
- Some of the aims of the group include: provision of **clarity on the Project's aims, structure, and timescale**, share updates on progress and latest findings, and **educate and share knowledge** on topics of interest related to construction. It will continue to provide a forum in which to **listen to and understand the views of stakeholders** from within the local community.

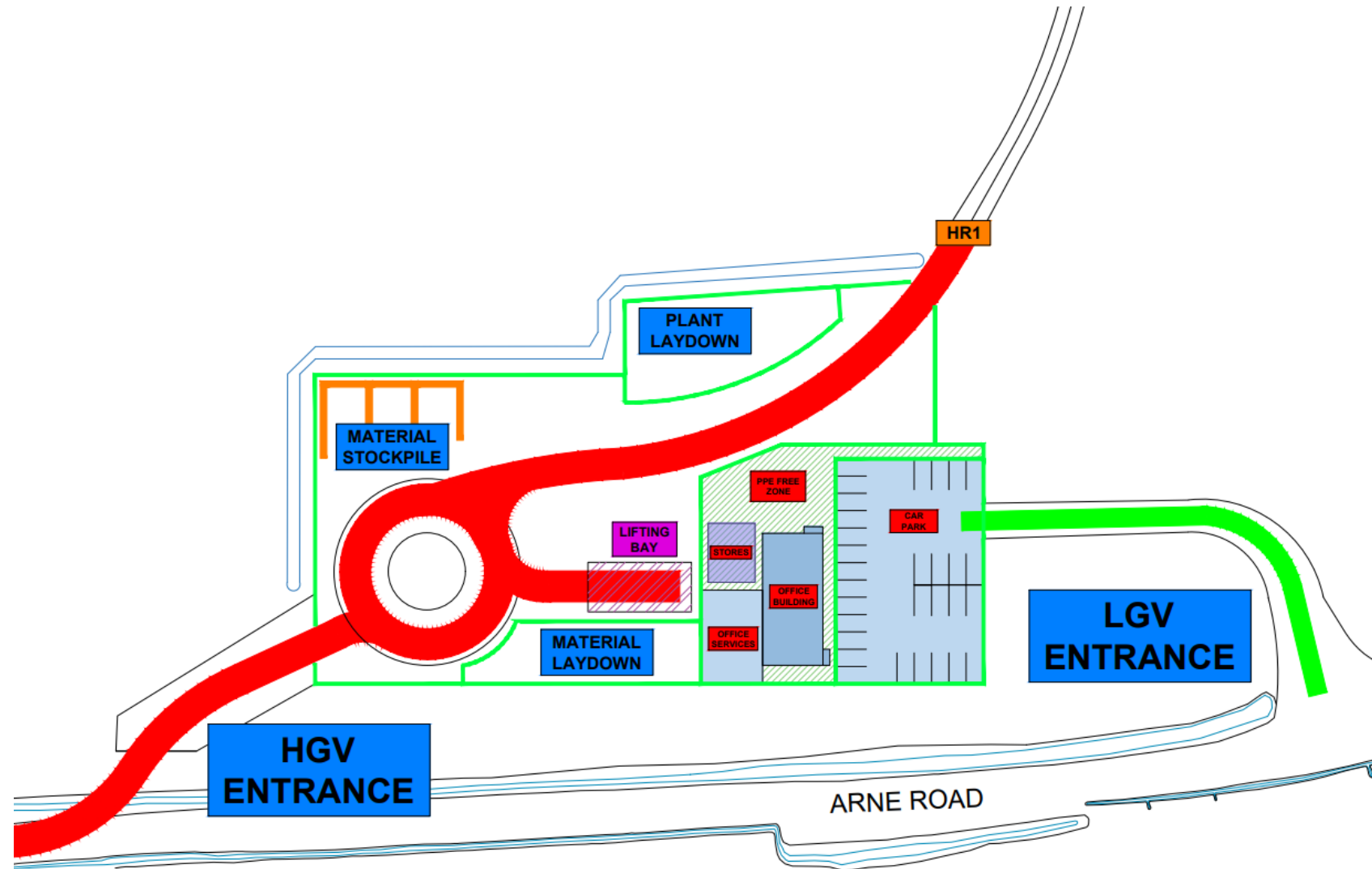

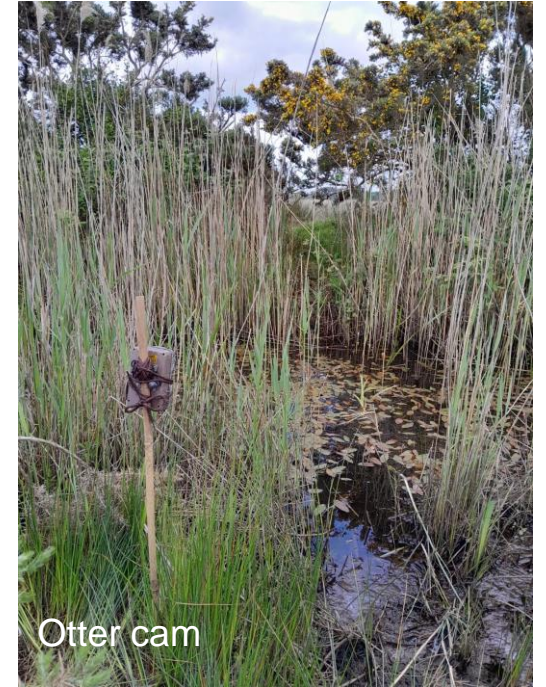

# Ecology update

- Most recent water vole survey has found population to be sparse
- Otter camera has not captured any evidence to date
- Viper's grass has been identified and fenced off
- Ground nesting birds not impacting works at present
- Botany and invertebrates surveys recently carried out
- Botany translocation should begin this year
