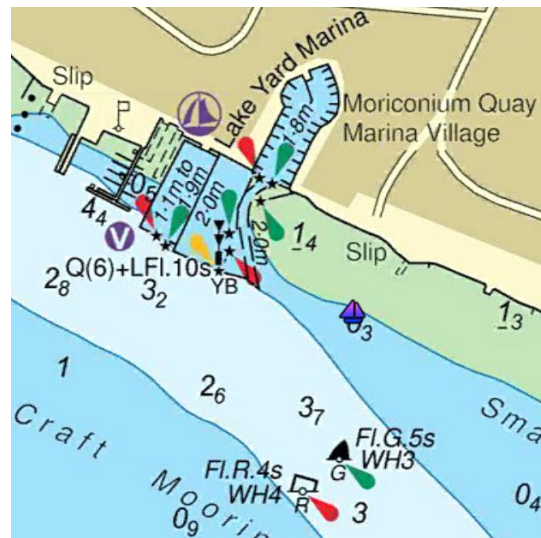


Wreck off Lake Road, Hamworthy

MARINERS ARE ADVISED of the sunken wreck of an 8-meter sailing yacht in approximate position **50° 42.65'N 002° 01.06'W** (see chartlet).

The yacht is understood to have caught fire and sank whilst at anchor. The wreck is approximately 150 meters north of WH3 Buoy and located directly off the slipway at Lake Road and is marked with a yellow wreck buoy until salvage can be arranged.



Mariners should keep well clear and navigate this area with extreme caution. This LNTM will remain in force until removal of the wreck and buoy.

Mariners are reminded that Radar, AIS, CCTV, Telephone and VHF Channels are recorded 24/7

Mariners are also hereby advised of the cancellation of LNTM 22 of 2023 (Obstruction in PWC Area now removed) and 23 of 2023 (East Looe Buoy now back on station)

Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Water Sport Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
